2017 BC Chinese Bridge Mandarin Singing Contest For University Students

General Information

1. Schedule

- Preliminary Round: Saturday, October 21st, 2017. It will be held as an audition, in which twenty-five songs will be selected to advance to the final round.
- Final Round: Saturday, November 4th, 2017. The final round will be held as a show, in which the first, second, third prizes as well as a number of outstanding performances will be awarded.

2. Qualification

Contestants must be students who have currently enrolled in universities/colleges in British Columbia, and who were born **outside** of regions and countries with Chinese as an official or social language. A copy of a birth certificate may be required for registration. Contestants may enter as a group, with a maximum of twelve vocalists.

The preliminary round will be held in three areas, Lower Mainland, Fraser Valley, and Vancouver Island. The locations for the preliminary contests are:

Lower Mainland: Confucius Institute at BCIT

Fraser Valley: University of Fraser Valley or Trinity Western University

Vancouver Island: University of Victoria

3. Registration

A complete set of rules and regulations will be provided on the registration site <http://www.confuciusbcit.com>, and contestants must indicate that they have read and will abide by the rules given.

Registration will be open between, Friday, September 22nd, 2017 and Monday, October 16th, 2017. Please note that the cut-off time for registration is 23:59 of October 16th, 2017.

The registration fee is \$5 for solo and duet performances, and \$10 for a group of four to twelve vocalists. Please give the registration fee to your instructor.

4. The Prizes

- First Prize: 1 Candidate - CAN\$300 cash
- Second Prize: 2 Candidates - CAN\$200 cash
- Third Prize: 3 Candidates - CAN\$100 cash

- Group Singing First-Place Prize: 1 Group - CAN\$300 cash
- Group Singing Second-Place Prize: up to 2 Groups - CAN\$200 cash
- Group Singing Third-Place Prize: up to 3 Groups - CAN\$100 cash

Other awards are

- Best Stage Appearance - CAN\$50 cash
- Highest Popularity Award - CAN\$50 cash
- Best Pronunciation Award - CAN\$50 cash
- Best Chinese Style Award - CAN\$50 cash
- Best Creativity Award - CAN\$50 cash
